

Mandatory Student Prerequisites

All applicants for entrance into the School are required to meet the following minimum criteria:

Initial EMT-

- Minimum 17 years old
- Possession of a high school diploma/GED or currently enrolled high school student.
- Proof of current CPR (may be differed if course is provided as part of class)
- Complete a class specific formal application with applicants signature
- Demonstration of appropriate immunizations as required by state, field, and clinical sites of the program or signed waivers for each of the immunizations.
- Proof of completed background check required by the department
- Review and attest in writing their acceptance and understanding of the EMT Functional Position Statement. *Attachment A: Functional Job Description / Testimonial Form*
- Review and attest in writing receipt of an agreement to adhere to the Southwest Memorial Hospital EMS Training Center Policy Manual. *Attachment B: Policy Agreement Testimonial Form*

Initial AEMT-

- Proof of current NREMT or Colorado EMT Certification
- Proof of current CPR
- Minimum 18 years old
- Possession of a high school diploma or GED
- Complete a class specific formal application with applicants signature
- Demonstration of appropriate immunizations as required by state, field, and clinical sites of the program or signed waivers for each of the immunizations.
- Proof of completed background check required by the department
- Review and attest in writing their acceptance and understanding of the EMT Functional Position Statement. *Attachment A: Functional Job Description / Testimonial Form*

Initial EMT-Intermediate

- Proof of current NREMT or Colorado EMT Certification
- Proof of current CPR
- Minimum 18 years old
- Possession of a high school diploma or GED

- Demonstration of appropriate immunizations as required by state, field, and clinical sites of the program or signed waivers for each of the immunizations.

Colorado IV Certification-

- Proof of current NREMT or Colorado EMT Certification
- Proof of current CPR GED or currently enrolled high school student.
- Minimum 18 years old
- Possession of a high school diploma / GED or currently enrolled high school student.
- Complete a class specific formal application with applicants signature
- Demonstration of appropriate immunizations as required by state, field, and clinical sites of the program or signed waivers for each of the immunizations.
- Proof of completed background check required by the department

Student Workers' Compensation and Liability Insurance

Students taking initial EMT, AEMT or IV certification courses will have Workers' Compensation and liability Insurance coverage. Proof of liability insurance is required for admission into the class if any clinical or hands on with real patients are involved. The following limits \$2,000,000 each incident or occurrence \$4,000,000 in the aggregate. There are 2 options for proof of liability insurance.

- You may purchase an individual professional liability insurance plan, you may contact www.HPSO.com or

- Have your service director provide a letter stating you will be covered under your service's liability insurance. In addition, we must have a copy of the policy with the letter.

Information regarding the insurance will be given to the student in a pre-admission packet prior to enrollment.
